1. Affirmation

Affirmation of an Elector of the County of Wyandotte, and State of Kansas desiring to vote an advance voting ballot

2. Voter Identification Requirements (Required)

Current Kansas Driver's License or KS ID number

You must provide either your Kansas driver's license number or a nondriver's identification card number. Voters over the age of 65 can provide an expired license number.

If you do not have a current Kansas driver's license or nondriver's ID card, you must submit a copy of a government-issued photo ID, such as a US passport or ID from another state with the application. For a list of other valid ID's, call the Election Office.
